

Supply List for **French Braid** –Discovery Day **Aug. 12, 2023**

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**Book: French Braid Quilts by Jane Hardy Miller with Arlene Netten**

The sample quilt is made from the pattern “Lucy’s Leftover Watercolor Kit” on page 20 of the book. Quilt size 55” x 74”.

**Fabric requirements as listed on the pattern:**

½ yard each of 10 fabrics for the braid run - fat quarters OK (but there's no room for cutting errors)

½ yard for accent squares - 2 fat quarters OK (but there's no room for cutting errors)

¼ yard for starting triangles - fat quarters OK if nondirectional (½ yard for one-way directional fabric)

¼ yard nondirectional for ending triangles - fat quarter OK (½ yard for one-way directional fabric)

**Borders, backing and binding**

¾ yard inner borders

1 yard outer borders (1 ⅞ yards if you prefer not to piece it)

3 ½ yards backing if pieced crosswise (4 ½ yards if pieced lengthwise)

½ yard for binding



**Other Sewing supplies:**

Rotary cutter & mat

Ruler -- a 4” or 5”x 21” ruler and/or a 2 ½” by 21” ruler

Sewing machine & accessories.

Scissors, pins, and your usual sewing supplies.

Thread to match your project or a neutral color.

Ironing boards and irons and power cords will be provided by the guild.
